The class is organized by modules and in order to move on to the next one, it really is important to put in the effort in mastering each of the earlier/basic modules. It's also important to work on the coding a little bit everyday or "re-do" coding independently that is not clear from class.

Take it, fabulous course

This is a good course if you want to get a very high level understanding of Python, R and programming in general. However don't expect that you'll be able to do a lot only on the basis of this course. It's a good start though.

You actually CAN learn to code.

It is very much a survey course of various tools -- the pace is quite quick, would recommend folks familiarize themselves with the key tools (i.e. Python and R) prior to joining. Given the number of tools covered, you will not leave with an in-depth understanding of any one. The idea is more to give you a better sense of what is available so you can pursue on your own (or through another course) at a later date.

Don't get caught up in simple bugs, learn the concepts.
